From the Desk of Pastor Lee

What a wonderful journey this Lent has been; it's been healing, it's been reflective, and it's been transformational. And now...and now we celebrate the resurrection. We are an Easter people, and the resurrection brings hope, it brings light in the midst of our darkness. We know this and yet somehow we still find ourselves going through rough times. We can still find ourselves in a crisis, living in fear, overwhelmed and simply tripped up by life. As Easter people, we are called to dance our dances of freedom for all the world to see—even and perhaps especially in times of great difficulty.

All of us have had bad days, bad weeks, months, even years. It's so easy to feel discouraged in this life, even if we have some blessings we can count on. Hopelessness and discouragement are so commonplace and pervasive that we often don't even notice them anymore. Like the air we breathe despair is always present and we've become so used to it that we barely notice it. And yet, we clearly see its effects on everyone...everywhere. As a result, at best we settle for a lesser life, at worst, we give up.

Jesus said that one of the main reasons He came to this world was to "seek and save that which was lost" (Luke 19:10), and "to give us LIFE TO THE FULL" (John 10:10). Jesus never said life would be perfect this side of heaven. However, He did say we could have victory and hope in every circumstance.

Ultimately, that's what "life to the full" means. Regardless of the circumstance Jesus HIMSELF will provide a way to have hope and victory in the circumstance. Jesus comes alongside of us and gives us a reason to celebrate as He walks with us in our every circumstance.

Remember as I said earlier.....As Easter people, we are called to dance our dances of freedom for all the world to see-even and perhaps especially in times of great difficulty. Dances of hope. Dances of justice. Dances of love. During this season, post-resurrection stories point to

the joy of living in the beloved community and extending that fellowship through our witness as we dare to dance again!

We hope you will join us on this journey post easter through Pentecost as we learn to dance in the rain instead of simply hunkering down and waiting for the storm to pass.
